Journey Planner App (Used by ALL danes)

Use <u>Journey planner</u> in browser og download the app. This is a search engine for public transport in Denmark and comes with updates in case of delays or cancellations of public transportation. Google Maps is also a commonly used for journey planning.

Getting to DTU - Guide

Most attendees are staying at Comfort Hotel Vesterbro. To be at DTU Campus in Lyngby at 9AM please follow these instructions:

08:00 – Leave the hotel and walk to **Vesterport station.** This takes 7 minutes.

If you do not have the DOT app. Tickets can be purchased at the 7/11 next to the stairs going down to the tracks. Tell them you need a ticket to **Lyngby Svømmehal busstop** or zone 1, 2, 30, 41 and 51.



08:14 – Take from track 3 the **A-train** – Blue line towards Hillerød (If you miss this connection, take the E-Train – Purple line towards Holte at 08:16). These trains run at intervals of 10 minutes.

08:31 – Get off the train at **Lyngby Station**

Walk past the flower shop and take a right along the pharmacy and outdoor store.

08:38 – Take **bus 180** (to Lyngby st.) or **300S** (to Gl. Holte, Øverødvej or DTU Rævehøjvej)

08:45 – Get off at **Lyngby Svømmehal** (**Lundtoftevej**) and walk 6 minutes to the Location of the Science Team Meeting at building 358 on Akademivej.


Going back to Copenhagen

As DTU is not next to a train station and you can therefore not buy physical ticket unless you bring Danish coins to pay the bus driver.

We therefore recommend downloading the **DOT app** as you then don't have to handle small change. See the example below on how to get back to Copenhagen.

In the app Copenhagen Central Station is called "København H".

Example: Buying ticket Lyngby to Vesterport



The app will automatically suggest your location, which in this case is zone 51, where DTU is situated.

After entering the destination Vesterport or "København H" click on the tick to continue, where it will show the different routes, you can take with public transport.

The most common route will be Bus 300S or 180 from **Lyngby Svømmehal** busstop to Lyngby station and further on with Train A or E (blue or purple line) to København H.

Pick the number of tickets you wish to purchase and press buy. The app takes Apple Pay and creditcard

The journey back

The journey back to Copenhagen is almost the same as the journey out. You must once again take the bus from **Lyngby Svømmehal** busstop and take train from Lyngby station, but this time with the **A-train** towards Hundige Station or the **E-train** towards Køge Station.

At Lyngby Station there is a viaduct under the tracks, which you must pass under to get to track number 3, where both train lines depart from.
